Annie and The Natural Wonder Band write songs and perform shows for the whole family to enjoy. Their fun-filled interactive shows include original music, great songs and dancing inspired by the wonders of the nature. Annie and her husband, Safari Bob will delight kids of all ages with their live performance as they sing songs about trees, bees, fleas, mammals, marsupials, flowers, frogs, whales, walruses, crabs, lobsters, fish, penguins, ants & spiders, bunnies, plants, water, wind, bugs, birds, dirt and snow. Plant a seed in your own decorative and personalized pot with artist Aimee Plantel or join artist Ann Contel as she demonstrates how you can decoupage cork coasters with recycled materials. Visitors can walk through the museum and see how installation artist Linda Price-Sneddon and students from Champion Charter make art with familiar materials in *My Nature/OUR Nature* and museum educators will be on hand to talk to parents and children about all the contemporary craft currently on exhibit.
