FULLER CRAFT MUSEUM ANNOUNCES NEWEST EXHIBITION -
2022 CRAFT BIENNIAL

Fuller Craft Museum is excited to announce the *2022 Craft Biennial* (formerly Members' Biennial) celebrating the diversity of talents in the museum's wide and expanding audience. This biennial exhibition is an important opportunity for emerging, mid-career, and veteran artists to exhibit their work to the Fuller Craft Museum community. Artists both inside and outside of New England have participated in the past, showcasing stunning works of ceramics, glassware, furniture, textiles, basketry, woodturning, jewelry, and other craft-based media. What's more, this exhibition has been particularly successful at bringing together communities of artists who are vital to the Fuller Craft Museum mission.

With an incredible 862 works of art submitted to this year's Craft Biennial, Juror Kimberly Winkle had the tough task of narrowing down the submissions to the 47 exhibiting artists showcasing a wide range of glass, ceramics, wood, fiber, metal, furniture, and jewelry.

ABOUT THE JUROR

Kimberly Winkle is a maker who creates furniture and objects using wood and paint; her work displays a balance of form, color and surface pattern. She has exhibited nationally and internationally, including SOFA Chicago, Wanted Design NYC and the Architectural Digest Home Show. Her work has been included in a number of publications, including *Fine Woodworking*, *Woodworker*, and *Woodworker West* magazines and the books *500 Tables*, *500 Chairs*, *Fine Woodworking Design Book 8*, among others. Winkle is a Professor of Art and Director of the School of Art, Craft & Design at Tennessee Technological University. She holds a Bachelor of Fine Art in Ceramics from the University of Oklahoma and a Master of Fine Art in Furniture Design from San Diego State University.
